HIGHLIGHTS

The first quarter of 2014 has been another busy period for JCLEC, delivering 28 courses to 505 participants. The recent [United Kingdom and Canadian Government Funded South East Asia Counter Terrorism Investigations Management Course](#) was attended by 28 senior officers, supporting the growth of counter terrorism policing throughout South East Asia and improving investigative skills and networks for participants.

The International DVI and Mortuary Management Course funded by JCLEC was delivered on 17 - 28 April. The course aims to give knowledge and managerial skills to command level officers (advanced level) about DVI procedures and process' based on principles and standards of Interpol.

On 19 March 2014, JCLEC Board of Management (BoM) and Board Of Supervisors (BoS) had their quarterly meeting where the discussion centered on our 10th anniversary in July 2014. Other topics included reviewing and giving acceptance for the 2013 Annual Report which will be released soon.

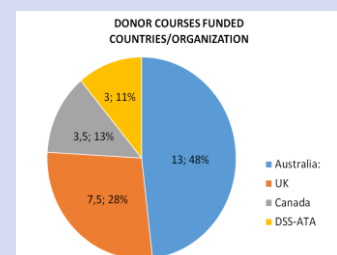
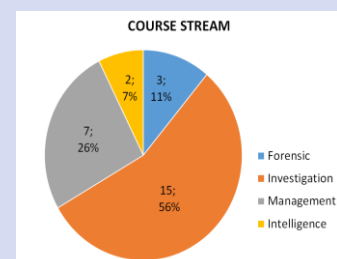
